Welcome to the Marlowes Health and Wellbeing Centre in Hemel Hempstead town centre.

The new centre is the result of two local NHS Trusts working together, Hertfordshire Partnership university NHS Foundation Trust (HPFT) and Hertfordshire Community NHS Trust (HCT), and is part of a wider project of investment in Hemel Hempstead.

Situated in Hemel Hempstead High Street, the centre is home to community mental and physical health services for adults and children. Having these services together under one roof means that:

- Patients, service users, carers and families receive joined up care
- Health care professionals are able to share expertise with each other in order to provide holistic care for local people.

Bus

The centre is located in Hemel Hempstead town centre with good public transport links. The centre is served by numerous bus routes including routes 2, 3, 4, 46, 301 and 532 which stop outside The Forum and additional bus and coach routes including 29, 31 and 759 which stop at West Herts College. Both bus stops are within a few minutes walk from the centre.

Train

The nearest train station is Hemel Hempstead station, just over one mile walk from the centre or a short bus ride.

Bike

There is space for bicycles to be parked in open bicycle hoops and motorbike parking bays at the rear of the centre.

Parking

Parking at the centre is very limited. It is for Blue Badge holders only, on a first come, first served basis. Service users, patients, parents and carers will need to park off site. There are several public car parks that are available close to the centre, including High Street, Water Gardens, Gadebridge Lane and Queensway car parks. There are also drop off spaces at the front of the site for people arriving by a taxi or private transport.
