

Child's Need: Speech, Language and/or Communication Difficulties at School

Referral is received.

Assessment of speech, language and communication skills completed by a therapist. This will take place in your child's school and you will be invited. The therapist will talk to you and school staff so that we can all decide together what should happen next.

Your child may not require direct support from the service at this time and their episode of care will be ended. The therapist will be able to signpost you to local support and provide you with advice about other services you may wish to access.

Your child's school may benefit from training and advice to help them to continue to support your child.

Your child may receive direct support from the Speech and Language Therapy Team. After this the episode of care will be ended so that you can continue to embed supportive strategies.

The therapist may set up a programme of specific activities for you and someone from your child's setting to carry out and practise. After this the episode of care will be ended so that you can continue to embed supportive strategies.
