## Speech and Language Virtual Screening Clinics

**Screening Clinics are for pre-school children, i.e. children who are 2 years 6 months and above and are not yet in full time school. If your child is in Reception class, please speak to school about your concerns.**

If your child is under 2 years 6 months, please speak to your Health Visitor and local Family Centre. They will be able to provide you with advice and support concerning early communication development, and give you some helpful ways of encouraging your child's talking at home.

**Please be aware** that we do not carry out assessments of eating and drinking at Screening clinics and we would not see a child who is currently receiving support from the service.

### **What to expect at a Screening clinic?**

To attend one of these clinics you will need to book via Eventbrite

- Once you have booked a date, we will send you some forms to provide us with information about your child and you are asked to email these back to us. Please check your junk/spam email folder.
- After we have received your completed forms we will confirm your individual time slot and send you all the information you need to log in and attend your child's appointment.
- Your place is not confirmed until we receive the completed forms.
