Our Understanding Sensory preferences information session is for teachers, assistants and SENCOs who would like to know more about children's sensory development. The focus is on sensory development, how sensory preferences are established and the influence on a child's sensory likes and dislikes. Sessions consider the impact of sensory preferences on everyday activities for children and offer practical advice and strategies that you can implement in your setting.
